AN ACT to amend the Governor-General's
Emoluments Act, 1964

[Assented to 22nd September, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Governor-General's ^{Short title}
Emoluments (Amendment) Act, 1972.

2. The Governor-General's Emoluments Act, 1964 is amended—

(a) in section 2 by substituting for paragraph (a) in subsections (1) and (2) respectively the following—

“(a) a salary at the rate of forty-two thousand dollars per annum”;
and

(b) by repealing and replacing section 5 as follows—

“Pension payable to surviving widow of a Governor-General

5. (1) Where a Governor-General dies while holding office there shall be granted to his widow an annual pension equivalent to two-thirds of the annual pension to which the Governor-General would have been entitled had he retired on the date of his death.

(2) Where a person dies after having retired from the office of Governor-General, there shall be granted to his widow an annual pension equivalent to two-thirds of the annual pension to which such person was entitled.

(3) Pension granted under this section, shall cease upon the remarriage of the recipient.”;

(c) in section 8 by substituting for paragraph (a) the following—

“(a) the official emoluments received by the Governor-General, the pension received by a retired Governor-General and by the widow of a Governor-General or retired Governor-General.”.

ment

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1971.
