THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SOUTH STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1982

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (South Steelband Panorama) Order, 1982.

Commence-
ment and
cessation

2. This Order shall be effective on the dates and on the times specified below—

Sunday, 7th February—from 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight;

Sunday, 14th February—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight.

Parking
prohibited
on certain
roads

3. No person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads—

(a) Princess Margaret Street; and

(b) Rambaransingh Street.

Parking
restricted

4. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2, vehicles may park as follows—

(a) Turton Street, on the western side only;

(b) Scott Street, on the southern side only;

(c) Ciperero Road, this is the road East of the traffic lights at Cross Crossing—on the northern side only.

(d) Lady Hailes Avenue—on the northern side only.

Competition
Skinner Park

5. Traffic to Skinner Park shall proceed along Lady Hailes Avenue.

Roads
closed

6. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2, the following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic—

(a) Ciperero Street, between Donaldson Street and Lady Hailes Avenue;

(b) Park Street, between Ciperero Street and Todd Street;

(c) Todd Street, between Scrimgeour Street and the eastern entrance to Skinner Park.

One-way
traffic

7. Vehicular traffic shall proceed along Shah Street in a northerly direction only.

Removal and
impounding
of vehicles
unlawfully
parked

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
