ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SOUTH JUNIOR CARNIVAL) ORDER, 1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (South Junior Carnival) Order, 1982. Citation
2. This Order comes into operation at 10.00 a.m. and ceases at 10.00 p.m. on Sunday, 21st February, 1982. Commencement and cessation
3. No person shall park any vehicle on any of the roads listed below— Parking prohibited
 - (a) Coffee Street, between Library Corner and Howard Lane;
 - (b) Harris Promenade to Coffee Street;
 - (c) Ciperio Street, between Coffee Street and Cross Crossing Traffic Lights.
4. During the times and on the date specified in paragraph 2, vehicles may be parked on the undermentioned roads as follows— Parking restricted
 - (a) Turton Street—on the western side only;
 - (b) Scott Street—on the southern side only;
 - (c) Ciperio Road—East of the Traffic Lights at Cross Crossing—on the northern side;
 - (d) Lady Hailes Avenue—on the northern side only;
 - (e) Park Street—on the southern side only.
5. Vehicles proceeding to Skinner Park must do so by way of Lady Hailes Avenue. Approach to Skinner Park
6. Vehicular traffic is restricted to the roads listed below as follows— Vehicular traffic restricted
 - (a) vehicles travelling along High Street shall not proceed beyond Library Corner;
 - (b) vehicles travelling West along Coffee Street shall not proceed beyond Howard Lane;
 - (c) vehicles travelling North along Ciperio Street shall not proceed beyond Lady Hailes Avenue;

- (d) vehicles travelling West on Carib Street shall not proceed beyond Howard Lane;
- (e) vehicles travelling South along Pointe-a-Pierre Road shall not proceed beyond St. James Street;
- (f) Ciperio Street shall be closed to all vehicular traffic; and
- (g) vehicles shall not travel North on Mucurapo Street, between Lord Street and Library Corner.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
