

LEGAL NOTICE No. 39

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS (PENSIONS) ACT, CHAP. 25:05

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS section 3 of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Act, Chap. 25:05 provides *inter alia* that the Council of a Corporation may by resolution declare a permanent office in the service of the Corporation for which separate provision is made in the annual estimates to be a pensionable office and that any such resolution shall be approved by resolution of the Senate and House of Representatives:

And whereas the Council of the Corporation of Port-of-Spain by resolution dated 25th May, 1978 declared the offices listed in the Schedule hereto, being permanent offices in the service of the Corporation of Port-of-Spain for which separate provision is made in the annual estimates of that Corporation, to be pensionable offices:

That this House approve the Resolution passed by the Port-of-Spain City Council on 25th May, 1978 and contained in the Schedule.
