

LEGAL NOTICE No. 48

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE STANDARDS ACT, 1972

IMPORT INSPECTION

ACTING UNDER the provisions of section 25 of the Standards Act, Chap. 82:03, it is notified for the information of the importing public that the Bureau of Standards proposes from 5th April 1982, to examine upon landing, goods to which standards apply including in the first instance the following compulsory standards:—

TTS 21 10 500: ...	... Requirements for labelling
Pt 2—1976 ...	... Labelling of Prepackaged Goods
Pt 3—1976 ...	... Labelling of Garments
Pt 7—1980 ...	... Labelling of Textiles
Pt 9—1980 ...	... Labelling of Footwear
TTS 26 25 500—1977	... Tungsten filament lamps for general service

For ease of reference the relevant sections of the Act are detailed hereunder:

Section 25(1) "The Minister may authorise any person and the Bureau may authorise any member of its staff to examine upon landing, goods for which a standard has been declared and which are produced or manufactured outside Trinidad and Tobago and any Customs entries in respect of such goods. A person authorised to examine goods under the section may take samples of such goods and submit such samples for analysis or testing section 25(3)". Where a standard declared is compulsory goods referred to in subsection (1) may be entered for home use, if and only if,

- (a) upon an examination of samples it is found that the goods comply with the compulsory standard; or
- (b) they are accompanied by certificate of examination and compliance with the compulsory standard, issued by a laboratory or other similar institution in the country of origin recognised by the Bureau.

Section 25(4)—In this section "entered for home use" means entered for consumption in Trinidad and Tobago.
