THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(LABOUR DAY CELEBRATIONS) ORDER, 1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Labour Day Celebrations) Order, 1982. Citation

2. This Order has effect from 9.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Saturday, 19th June, 1982. Duration of Order

3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following roads:— Road closed to vehicular traffic and parking prohibited

- (a) Fyzabad-Oropouche Road, between Delhi Road Junction and Fyzabad Junction;
- (b) Fyzabad-Guapo Road, between No. 22 Road and Fyzabad Junction;
- (c) Fyzabad-Siparia Road, between Fyzabad Junction and Lum Tack Hill;
- (d) Lum Tack Hill, between the C.M. School and Delhi Road Junction.

4. No. 22 Road and Fyzabad-Guapo Road, between the junctions of No. 37 Road and No. 22 Road, shall be open only to vehicular traffic proceeding to the ceremonies at the Tesoro Recreation Ground. Traffic restricted

5. Vehicular traffic proceeding:— Vehicular routes

- (a) in the direction of Siparia and beyond, from Delhi Road shall do so via Fyzabad-Oropouche Road then into Lum Tack Hill South and thereafter into Fyzabad-Siparia Road;
- (b) from Siparia,
 - (i) in the direction of Oropouche and beyond, shall do so via the Fyzabad-Siparia Road then into Lum Tack Hill South and on to Fyzabad-Oropouche Road;
 - (ii) in the direction of Forest Reserve and beyond shall do so via No. 37 Road and through the junction at Hi-Lo Supermarket.

Bus routes

6. Notwithstanding the prohibitions and restrictions contained in this Order, Public Transport Service Corporation buses may ply their regular routes.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
