MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (SUMMER RACE MEETING)
(TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ORDER, 1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Summer Citation
Race Meeting) (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1982.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 10.30 a.m. and ^{Effective}
7.00 p.m. on the following dates—_{dates}

Saturday, 26th June, 1982;

Saturday, 3rd July, 1982;

Saturday, 10th July, 1982;

Saturday, 17th July, 1982;

Saturday, 24th July, 1982;

Saturday, 31st July, 1982;

Monday, 2nd August, 1982; and

Saturday, 7th August, 1982.

3. Subject to paragraph 4, no person may park or cause or permit ^{Parking}
any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads—_{prohibited}

(a) Queen's Park West between Cipriani Boulevard and
Queen's Park East;

(b) Chancery Lane;

(c) Dundonald Street between Queen's Park West and Albion
Street;

(d) Dere Street;

(e) Cummins Lane;

(f) Albion Street between Dundonald Street and Chancery
Lane; and

(g) Melville Lane.

4. Notwithstanding the prohibitions in paragraph 3, taxis may ^{Parking}
park in the Taxi Stands on Queen's Park West and on Dere Street. _{prohibited}

5. Motorists using car parks "A" and "B" in the Queen's Park Savannah, shall park their vehicles—

- (a) facing West in Car Park "A";
- (b) facing East in Car Park "B".

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
