1. This Order may be cited as the Ceremonial Opening of the  
1982-1983 Law Term of the Supreme Court of Judicature of the  
Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1982. Citation

2. This Order takes effect from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon on Monday,  
October 4, 1982. Commence-  
ment and  
cessation

3. No person shall park a vehicle on the following roads—

- (a) Richmond Street between Duke Street and Sackville Street; Parking  
prohibited  
on certain  
roads
- (b) St. Vincent Street between Duke Street and Queen Street;
- (c) Sackville Street between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (d) Abercromby Street between Queen Street and Knox Street;
- (e) Knox Street between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (f) Edward Street between Queen Street and Duke Street;
- (g) Hart Street;
- (h) on the grounds on the southern and western sides of the Red House, South of Sackville Street.

4. Between the hours of 10.45 a.m. and 12.00 noon on the date  
specified in paragraph 2, vehicular traffic will be diverted as follows: Traffic  
diversion

- (a) vehicles proceeding South along Richmond Street will be diverted West into Charles Street;
- (b) vehicles proceeding East along Sackville Street will be diverted South into Richmond Street;
- (c) vehicles proceeding North along Edward Street will be diverted West into Queen Street;

- (d) vehicles proceeding South along St. Vincent Street will be diverted West into Duke Street; and
- (e) vehicles proceeding North along Abercromby Street will be diverted West into Queen Street.

5. A vehicle that is parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(a) and (b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
