**Act No. 7 of 1975**

AN ACT to amend the Income Tax Ordinance,  
Ch. 33. No. 1.

*[Assented to 27th March, 1975]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Income Tax (Amend-<sup>Short title</sup>  
ment) Act, 1975.

2. In section 18c the Income Tax Ordinance is amended as follows:—

(a) in subsections (1) and (3) by deleting the words “twenty-five thousand dollars” and substituting therefor the words “thirty thousand dollars” for the year of income 1973; and by deleting the words “thirty thousand dollars” and substituting therefor the words “forty thousand dollars” for the year of income 1974 and, subject to subsection (4), subsequent years of income;

(b) by adding immediately after subsection (3) the following new subsection:—

“(4) For the year of income 1975 and subsequent years of income the Minister may by Order published in the *Gazette* vary the amounts specified in subsections (1) and (3).”.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1973.
