ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 44F(1)  
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1981

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Steelband Panorama) Order, 1981. Citation

2. This Order shall be effective on the dates and times specified below— Commence-  
ment and  
cessation

Sunday, 15th February, 1981—from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00  
midnight.

Friday, 20th February, 1981—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00  
midnight;

Thursday, 26th February, 1981—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00  
midnight;

Saturday, 28th February, 1981—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00  
midnight;

3. During the dates and on the times specified in paragraph 2, no person may park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads:— Parking  
prohibited

(a) Queen's Park West except for taxis plying for hire in  
the Taxi Stands;

(b) Dere Street;

(c) Chancery Lane;

(d) Albion Street between Victoria Avenue and Chancery  
Lane;

(e) Pembroke Street between New Street and Keate Street;

(f) Frederick Street between New Street and Queen's Park  
West;

(g) Keate Street;

(h) Queen's Park East between Jerningham Avenue and  
Queen's Park West;

(i) Charlotte Street between Queen's Park West and Gordon  
Street;

(j) Cipriani Boulevard—on the eastern side only (except for  
trucks conveying steelband instruments);

(k) Gordon Street between Charlotte Street and Chancery  
Lane;

- (l) Victoria Avenue between Queen's Park West and Albion Street except for taxis plying for hire on the Queen's Park Taxi Stand; and
- (m) Dundonald Street between Albion Street and Queen's Park West.
- Parking restricted**
4. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 2, parking shall be restricted on the undermentioned roads as follows:—
- (a) Stanmore Avenue between Queen's Park West and Tranquillity Street—on the western side only;
- (b) Dundonald Street between Albion Street and Tragarete Road—on the eastern side only; and
- (c) Victoria Avenue between Albion Street and Tragarete Road—on the eastern side only.
- One-way traffic**
5. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2, vehicular traffic shall proceed as indicated below:—
- (a) Keate Street between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction only;
- (b) Chancery Lane between Keate Street and Queen's Park West—in a northerly direction only;
- (c) Albion Street—in an easterly direction only.
- Road closed**
6. The following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic:—
- (a) Frederick Street between Keate Street and Queen's Park West; and
- (b) Queen's Park West between Queen's Park East and Frederick Street.
- Traffic restricted to certain vehicles**
7. Only vehicles conveying steelband instruments and taxis plying for hire from Princes Building Taxi Stand shall be allowed to travel along Queen's Park West, between Chancery Lane and Frederick Street.
- Parking of vehicles on Queen's Park Savannah**
8. Notwithstanding any other enactment to the contrary parking on the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of the police officers on duty as follows:—
- (a) on Sunday, 15th February, 1981—from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight;
- (b) on Friday, 20th February, 1981; Thursday, 26th February, 1981; and Saturday, 28th February, 1981, } from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 mid-night
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked.**

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78c of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance.
