MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 44F(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SOUTH STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1981

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (South Steelband Panorama) Order, 1981. Citation
2. This Order shall come into operation at 8.00 a.m. and shall cease at 11.30 p.m. on 14th February, 1981. Commence-
ment and
cessation
3. No person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads:— Parking
prohibited
on certain
roads
 - (a) Princess Margaret Street; and
 - (b) Rambaransingh Street.
4. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2, vehicles may park as follows:— Parking
restricted
 - (a) Turton Street—on the western side only;
 - (b) Scott Street—on the southern side only;
 - (c) Ciperro Road—i.e., road East of the Traffic Lights at Cross Crossing—on the northern side only; and
 - (d) Lady Hailes Avenue—on the northern side only.
5. Traffic to Skinner Park shall proceed along Lady Hailes Avenue. Competition
Skinner
Park
6. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2, the following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic:— Road closed
 - (a) Ciperro Street between Donaldson Street and Lady Hailes Avenue;
 - (b) Park Street between Ciperro Street and Todd Street; and
 - (c) Todd Street between Scrimgeour Street and the eastern entrance to Skinner Park.
7. Vehicular traffic shall proceed along Shah Street in a northerly direction only. One-way
traffic
8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78C of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance. Removal and
impounding
of vehicles
unlawfully
parked.
