NOTICE

ISSUED UNDER SECTION 7(1) OF THE PETROLEUM ACT, 1969

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of section 7(1) of the Petroleum Act, 1969, notice is hereby given that Texaco Trinidad Inc. has made written application to the Minister of Energy and Energy-based Industries for a Pipeline Licence to lay a 152 mm (6-inch) pipeline consisting of two sections for the transport of natural gas from the Gathering Station at Lot 8 to the existing 300 mm (12-inch) Point Liguore—Forest Reserve gas line and subject to consideration of any objections which may be received by him pursuant to this Notice, the Minister of Energy and Energy-based Industries proposes to issue to Texaco Trinidad Inc. a Pipeline Licence to construct, install, maintain and operate the pipeline described in the Schedule hereunder along the route detailed and shown on the attached map.

Any person who objects to the laying of such a pipeline on the grounds specified in section 8 of the Petroleum Act, is hereby invited to give notice of his objections and of the grounds on which he relies in support thereof to the Minister of Energy and Energy-based Industries within thirty days of the publication of this Notice.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO ABOVE—DESCRIPTION OF PIPELINE

<i>Route</i>	Between Gathering Station at Lot 8 and existing 300 mm (12-inch) Point Liguore—Forest Reserve Gas line at Points "A"—"C" as shown on the attached plan.
<i>Length</i>	1484 metres (4,870 feet).
<i>Specifications of Pipeline</i>	152 mm (6-inch) nominal diameter; thickness 6.3 mm (0.25 inches); ASTM A106 Grade B seamless pipe.
<i>Material of Construction</i>	Carbon steel.
<i>Fabrication and Coating</i>	The line pipe will be welded together in accordance with API code 1104. The pipeline would be coated with extruded polyethylene (X-Tru Cote). Sacrificial anodes would be installed on the line.
<i>Depth of line</i>	The line will be buried to a minimum depth of 0.91 metres (3 feet).
<i>Fluid for Transmission</i>	Natural Gas.
<i>Operating pressure</i>	17 bars (250 psi).
<i>Estimated capacity</i>	283,000 cubic metres/day (10 mmscfd).

<i>Owner of the land over which line will pass</i>	The State.
<i>Estimated Cost</i>	\$146,000 T.T.
