A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 67 of the Summary Offences Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 17, that the President may, by Proclamation, define the period known as Carnival, during which, subject to the regulations made under subsection (2) of the said section, persons may appear masked or otherwise disguised:

And whereas it is expedient that the period known as the Carnival in respect of the year 1981 should be defined:

Now, therefore, I, ELLIS EMMANUEL INNOCENT CLARKE, President as aforesaid, do hereby order and proclaim that the period known as the Carnival shall in respect of the year 1981 commence at 4.00 o'clock in the morning of Monday, 2nd March, 1981 and shall end at 12.00 o'clock midnight on Tuesday, 3rd March, 1981.
