THE REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1981

1. These Rules may be cited as the Registration (Amendment) Rules, 1981. Citation

2. The Registration Rules, 1967 are amended by inserting immediately after rule 31 the following new rule— Registra-

31A. (1) Where it is not possible to issue an identification card, the Elections and Boundaries Commission until 31st December, 1981 may, for the purposes of complying with these Rules, issue to a registered person a temporary identification card and such temporary identification card shall, subject to paragraph (2), be in the form set out in Form No. 14 in the Fifth Schedule.

(2) The temporary identification card shall serve the same function and contain the same features as the identification card except that the following information shall appear on the temporary identification card before it undergoes the process of lamination—

- (a) the name and registration record card number of the registered person inserted in writing;
- (b) the name, imprinted by means of a rubber stamp of the Registration Office at which the card was prepared;
- (c) the words, imprinted by means of a rubber stamp “Issued by the Elections and Boundaries Commission”.
