THE LATE DR. ERIC WILLIAMS STATE MEMORIAL SERVICE  
(TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ORDER, 1981

1. This Order may be cited as the Late Dr. Eric Williams State Memorial Service (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1981. Citation

2. This Order has effect from 8.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Saturday, 11th April, 1981. Commencement and cessation

3. Parking of vehicles is prohibited on the following roads: Parking prohibition on certain roads

- Hart Street;
- Abercromby Street between Independence Square South and Duke Street;
- Knox Street;
- Frederick Street between Duke Street and Independence Square North;
- Independence Square North between St. Vincent and Duncan Streets;
- Independence Square South between Duncan Street and Broadway;
- Duncan Street between South Quay and Queen Street;
- Nelson Street between Queen Street and South Quay;
- George Street between South Quay and Queen Street;
- Charlotte Street between Queen Street and South Quay;
- Henry Street between South Quay and Queen Street;
- Queen Street between Piccadilly and St. Vincent Streets.

4. The following roads are closed to vehicular traffic— Streets closed

- Hart Street;
- Abercromby Street between Independence Square South and Duke Street;
- Knox Street;
- Frederick Street between Duke Street and Independence Square North;
- Independence Square North between St. Vincent and Duncan Streets;
- Independence Square South between Piccadilly and Henry Streets;

Nelson Street between Queen Street and South Quay;  
 George Street between South Quay and Queen Street;  
 Charlotte Street between Queen Street and South Quay;  
 Henry Street between South Quay and Queen Street;  
 Chacon Street between Queen Street and Independence  
 Square South.
