MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1)  
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE SANTA ROSA PARK RACES (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
ORDER, 1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Santa Rosa Park Races Citation  
(Temporary Provisions) Order, 1982.

2. This Order has effect from 11.30 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on the following dates:—

Saturday, 14th August, 1982;

Saturday, 21st August, 1982;

Saturday, 28th August, 1982;

Tuesday, 31st August, 1982;

Saturday, 4th September, 1982;

Saturday, 11th September, 1982;

Saturday, 18th September, 1982.

3. During the times and dates specified in paragraph 2, no person shall park any vehicle on the following roads:—

(a) O'Meara Road;

(b) O'Meara Ferry Road, between Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and a point of 185 metres (200 yards) South of the eastern entrance to Santa Rosa Park;

(c) Churchill-Roosevelt Highway between the western entrance to Santa Rosa Park and O'Meara Road;

(d) the roads leading to and from the Arima Race Club Buildings.

4. (1) Between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.—
- (a) vehicular traffic shall enter Santa Rosa Park from the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway by way of the western entrance and shall leave by way of the north-eastern entrance;
  - (b) vehicular traffic shall proceed in a northerly direction only between the eastern entrance to the Race Stand and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.
- (2) Between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m.—
- (a) vehicular traffic shall enter Santa Rosa Park by way of O'Meara Ferry Road and shall leave by way of the western entrance leading to the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway;
  - (b) vehicular traffic shall proceed in a southerly direction only along O'Meara Ferry Road between Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and the eastern entrance to Santa Rosa Park.

5. Vehicles using Santa Rosa Park shall park in accordance with the direction of the police on duty.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence vehicles parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
