| Citation                   | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control (Experimental Scheme) (Barataria/Aranguez/Curepe/Tunapuna) Regulations, 1985.   |
| Commencement and cessation | 2. These Regulations come into effect at 5.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 1st May, 1985, and cease at 5.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 31st July, 1985.  |
| Access from Fifth Street   | 3. (1) Vehicles travelling East along Fifth Street, Barataria, may gain access to— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Sixth Avenue by turning right into Seventh Avenue and then left into Sixth Street;</li> <li>(b) Eastern Main Road by turning left into El Socorro Road.</li> </ul> (2) Vehicles travelling West along Fifth Street may gain access to— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Sixth Avenue by turning left into Fifth Avenue and then right into Seventh Street;</li> <li>(b) Churchill-Roosevelt Highway by turning left into Tenth Avenue.</li> </ul>                                  |
| No turning—<br>Barataria   | 4. Vehicles may not turn from Fifth Street, Barataria into Sixth Avenue.   |
| Parking prohibited         | 5. Parking is prohibited— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) in Barataria—           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) on Fifth Street from Seventh Avenue to Fifth Avenue;</li> <li>(ii) on Sixth Avenue from Seventh Street to Fifth Street;</li> </ul> </li> <li>(b) in Aranguez—           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) on the Eastern Main Road between Saddle Road and Aranguez Road;</li> <li>(ii) on Fifth Street between El Socorro Road to Don Miguel Road;</li> </ul> </li> <li>(c) in Tunapuna on Centenary Street from Eastern Main Road to the Priority Bus Route.</li> </ul> |

6. Parking is permitted in Barataria—

- (a) on Sixth Street, between Sixth Avenue and Fifth Avenue, on the southern side;
- (b) on Sixth Street, between Seventh Avenue and Sixth Avenue, on the northern side;
- (c) on Tenth Avenue, between Fifth Street and Ninth Street, on the eastern side.

7. Vehicles may not stop or park in San Juan—

Stopping or

- (a) on the Eastern Main Road from a point fifty metres West of Saddle Road to a point fifty metres East of Aranguéz Road;
- (b) El Socorro Road on the eastern side, between Backchain Street and Railway Road; and
- (c) El Socorro Road on the western side, between Martin Trace and Fifth Street.

8. Vehicles shall proceed—

One-way  
traffic

(a) in Barataria—

- (i) on Fifth Street between Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and Tenth Avenue in an easterly direction;
- (ii) on Sixth Street between Seventh Avenue and Fifth Avenue in an easterly direction;
- (iii) on Seventh Street between Fifth Avenue and Seventh Avenue in a westerly direction;
- (iv) on Fifth Avenue between Fifth Street and Seventh Street in a southerly direction;
- (v) on Seventh Avenue between Fifth Street and Sixth Street in a southerly direction;

(b) in San Juan—

- (i) on Aranguéz Road between the Eastern Main Road and Railway Road (Fifth Street) in a southerly direction;
- (ii) on Bridge Road between Savannah Road and Neverson Street in a westward and northward direction;
- (iii) on Neverson Street between Bridge Road and Savannah Road in an easterly direction;
- (iv) on Savannah Road between Neverson Street and Bridge Road in a southerly direction;
- (v) on Maloney Street between Eastern Main Road and Byatt Street in a westerly direction;

(c) in Curepe—

(i) on Scott Street between the Eastern Main Road and Sellier Street in a northerly direction;

(ii) on Evans Street between—

(A) Connell Street and the Southern Main Road in a westerly direction;

(B) Broome Street and the Southern Main Road in an easterly direction.

No right

9. Vehicles may not turn from the Eastern Main Road, Curepe, into—

(a) Riverside Road;

(b) Southern Main Road.

No left  
turn—  
San Juan

10. Vehicles may not turn from Railway Road, San Juan, into Aranguéz Road.

Aranguéz

11. Twenty-five (25) taxis plying the El Socorro/Aranguéz routes may park facing East in the taxi stand on the northern side of Railway Road, the most westerly part of the stand being at the junction of El Socorro Road.

12. (1) Fifteen (15) taxis plying the Chaguanas and San Fernando routes may park in the taxi stand on the northern side of Evans Street between Broome Street and the Southern Main Road, the most easterly part of the taxi stand being ten metres West of the Southern Main Road.

(2) Twelve (12) taxis plying the Chaguanas and San Fernando routes may park in the taxi stand on the southern side of Evans Street between Connell Street and the Southern Main Road the most westerly part of the taxi stand being ten metres East of the Southern Main Road.
