THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(CHURCHILL-ROOSEVELT HIGHWAY—CUREPE TO MACOYA)
REGULATIONS, 1985

- Citation** 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control (Experimental Scheme) (Churchill-Roosevelt Highway—Curepe to Macoya) Regulations, 1985.
- Commencement and cessation** 2. These Regulations come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 1st May, 1985 and cease at 6.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 31st July, 1985.
- Intersections closed** 3. The intersections of the following roads and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway are closed:
- (a) Eccles Street;
 - (b) Rapsey Street;
 - (c) Stella (Bassie) Street;
 - (d) Bedassie Street;
 - (e) Dookiesingh Street;
 - (f) Freeman Street;
 - (g) Dry River Trace;
 - (h) Streatham Lodge Road—South;
 - (i) Deenah Trace—South; and
 - (j) Centenary Street.
- One-way traffic** 4. Vehicular traffic proceeding along Watts Street between Streatham Lodge Road and Freeman Street, is permitted to travel in an easterly direction only.
