THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1983

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Steelband Panorama) Order, 1983.

Commence-
ment and
cessation

2. This Order has effect during the times and dates specified as follows:—

Friday 28th January, 1983—from 5.00 p.m. to 2.00 a.m. on
Saturday, 29th January;

Sunday 30th January, 1983—from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00
midnight;

Friday 4th February, 1983—from 5.00 p.m. to 2.00 a.m. on
Saturday, 5th February, 1983;

Thursday 10th February, 1983—from 5.00 p.m. to 2.00 a.m.
on Friday, 11th February, 1983;

Saturday 12th February, 1983—from 5.00 p.m. to 2.00 a.m.
on Sunday, 13th February, 1983.

Parking
prohibited

3. Parking is prohibited on any of the following roads:—

Queen's Park West except for taxis plying for hire in the
Taxi Stand;

Chancery Lane;

Albion Street between Victoria Avenue and Chancery Lane;

Pembroke Street between New Street and Keate Street;

Frederick Street between New Street and Queen's Park West;

Keate Street;

Queen's Park East between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's
Park West;

Charlotte Street between Queen's Park West and New Street;

Cipriani Boulevard—on the eastern side only except for
trucks conveying steelband instruments;

Gordon Street between Charlotte Street and Dundonald
Street;

Victoria Avenue between Queen's Park West and Albion
Street except for taxis plying for hire on the Queen's
Park Taxi Stands; and

Dundonald Street between Gordon Street and Queen's Park
West.

4. Vehicles may park on the roads mentioned below as follows:— Parking restricted
 - Stanmore Avenue between Queen's Park West and Tranquillity Street—on the western side only;
 - Dundonald Street between Gordon Street and Tragarete Road—on the eastern side only;
 - Victoria Avenue between Albion Street and Tragarete Road—on the eastern side only; and
 - Dere Street between Cummins Lane and Melville Lane—on the western side only.

5. Vehicles shall proceed as indicated below:— One-way traffic
 - Keate Street between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction only;
 - Chancery Lane between Keate Street and Queen's Park West—in a northerly direction only;
 - Albion Street—in an easterly direction only.

6. The following roads are closed to vehicular traffic— Roads closed
 - Frederick Street between Keate Street and Queen's Park West; and
 - Queen's Park West between Queen's Park East and Frederick Street.

7. Only taxis plying for hire from the Princes Building Taxi Stand and vehicles conveying steelband instruments are allowed to travel along Queen's Park West, between Chancery Lane and Frederick Street. Traffic restricted

8. Vehicles may be parked on the Queen's Park Savannah in accordance with the directions of the Police on duty. Parking of vehicles on Queen's Park Savannah

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50
