ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(ARIMA BOROUGH DAY PARADE) ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Arima Borough Day Parade) Order, 2026.

2. This Order has effect on Saturday 8th August, 2026, from 12.00 p.m. to midnight. Duration

3. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on—

Parking  
prohibited

- (a) Industry Street, between Eastern Main Road and Anglican Street;
- (b) Anglican Street, between Industry Street and King Street;
- (c) King Street, between Lopez Street and Church Street;
- (d) Cocorite Road, between Broadway and Quesnel Street; and
- (e) Beckles Lane, between Arima Old Road and Eastern Main Road.

4. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park or proceed on—

Vehicular  
traffic and  
parking  
prohibited

- (a) Queen Street, between Sorzano Street and Hollis Avenue;
- (b) Queen Street, between Hollis Avenue and Lord Kitchener Avenue;
- (c) Robinson Circular, between Lord Kitchener Avenue and Railway Road;
- (d) Hollis Avenue, between Eastern Main Road and Woodford Street;
- (e) Woodford Street, between Hollis Avenue and Sorzano Street;
- (f) Sorzano Street, between Woodford Street and Queen Street;
- (g) St. Joseph Street, between Hollis Avenue and Green Street;
- (h) Green Street, between St. Joseph Street and Prince Street;

- (i) Farfan Street, between St. Joseph Street and Prince Street;
- (j) Devenish Street, between Queen Street and Prince Street;
- (k) Railway Road, between Providence Circular and Eastern Main Road; and
- (l) Railway Road and Queen Mary Avenue, between the Priority Bus Route and Eastern Main Road.

5. (1) The parade of the bands shall proceed south along Queen Street from Sorzano Street, continuing south along Lord Kitchener Avenue, then west along Robinson Circular, then north along Railway Road, then east along Hollis Avenue to Woodford Street, then north along Woodford Street to Sorzano Street, then east along Sorzano Street to Queen Street.

(2) The parade of the bands shall commence at 2.00 p.m. and shall end at 10.00 p.m.

Taxi stand  
relocation

6. The following taxi stands are relocated as follows:

- (a) the Calvary Hill Taxi Stand, to the eastern side of Prince Street, with taxis facing north;
- (b) the Sangre Grande Taxi Stand, to the southern side of Sorzano Street, with taxis facing east;
- (c) the Pinto Road Taxi Stand, to the southern side of Broadway near its intersection with Cocorite Road, with taxis facing east;
- (d) the La Horquetta Taxi Stand, to the eastern side of Maurice Avenue near the intersection with Cocorite Road, with taxis facing south;
- (e) the Brazil/Talparo Taxi Stand, to the eastern side of Llanos Street near its intersection with Cocorite Road, with taxis facing south;
- (f) the Malabar Taxi Stand, to the western side of Lord Kitchener Avenue, in the vicinity of the Election and Boundaries Office, with taxis facing south;
- (g) the O'Meara Road (now known as Lisa Morris-Julien Boulevard)/Carapo Taxi Stand, to the northern side of Devenish Street near its intersection with Cocorite Road, with taxis facing east; and
- (h) the Arima Old Road/Cleaver Road Taxi Stand, to the eastern side of King Street, near the intersection with Hollis Avenue, with taxis facing south.

7. The Port-of-Spain to Arima Route Red Band Maxi Taxis that ply <sup>Maxi taxi</sup> for hire along the Eastern Main Road and along the Priority Bus Route <sup>stands</sup> shall operate on St. Joseph Street, between Green Street and Broadway Street.

8. A driver of an emergency vehicle shall proceed west along <sup>Emergency</sup> Broadway onto the Arima Old Road, then south onto Beckles Lane, <sup>route</sup> then east onto the Eastern Main Road and then south onto Prince Bartholomew Drive to enter the compound of the Arima District Health Facility.

9. The muster point is located at the Hearty Foods Car Park, at <sup>Muster point</sup> the intersection of Pro Queen Street and Sorzano Street.

10. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of <sup>Removal and</sup> a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this <sup>impounding</sup> Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with <sup>of vehicles</sup> sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. <sup>unlawfully</sup> parked
