A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 50 of the Constitution of Trinidad and Tobago that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may, at any time prorogue or dissolve Parliament:

And Whereas it is deemed expedient that Parliament be prorogued:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby declare that Parliament shall stand prorogued on the 21st day of January, 1966.
