## RESOLUTION

PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE  
INDEPENDENCE LOANS ACT, 1964

## ISSUE OF BONDS

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 3 of the Independence Development Loans Act, 1964, the Government is authorized to borrow money either in the currency of the United States of America or in the currency of Trinidad and Tobago:

And whereas under the provisions of section 4 of the said Act the Minister of Finance may, for the purpose of securing the repayment of loans made under section 3 of the said Act, issue Bonds for terms of twenty years payable semi-annually and bearing interest at the rate of three per cent. per annum in such denomination as may be specified by resolution passed by the House of Representatives:

And whereas under the provisions of the said Act Government has agreed to borrow from the institutions enumerated in the Schedule hereto the sums of money appearing opposite their respective names on security of bonds in authorized denominations:

*Be it resolved :*

That bonds in denominations of \$1,000 or multiples thereof be issued to the institutions enumerated in the Schedule hereto.
