RESOLUTION

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS (PENSIONS) ORDINANCE, CH. 39. No. 13

PENSIONABLE OFFICES—COUNCIL OF THE  
SAN FERNANDO CORPORATION

WHEREAS section 3 of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 13, provides *inter alia* that the Council of a Corporation may by resolution declare a permanent office in the service of the Corporation for which separate provision is made in the annual estimates to be a pensionable office and that any such resolution shall be approved by Resolution of the House of Representatives:

And whereas the Council of the San Fernando Corporation by resolution dated the 19th day of June, 1965, has declared the offices of Town Superintendent and Inspector, being permanent offices in the service of the San Fernando Corporation for which separate provision is made in the annual estimates of that Corporation, to be pensionable offices with effect from the year 1963:

*Be it resolved:*

That this House approve the resolution of the Council of the San Fernando Corporation shown as an Appendix hereto.

APPENDIX

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS by letter dated 4th October, 1963, the Council received approval of the abolition of the post of Assistant Borough Engineer and its replacement by that of Town Superintendent.

And whereas the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 7, was amended by Act No. 18 of 1964 to provide for the rank of Inspector of the Borough Police Force.

And whereas it has always been the intention of the Council that these new posts should be pensionable,

*Be it resolved* that the offices of the Corporation set out in the second column of the following schedule be declared pensionable from 1963.

RESOLUTION

THE INDEPENDENCE DEVELOPMENT LOANS ACT, 1964

ISSUE OF BONDS TO SHELL (TRINIDAD) LTD.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 3 of the Independence Development Loans Act, 1964, the Government of Trinidad and Tobago is authorised to borrow money either in the currency of the United States of America or in the currency of Trinidad and Tobago:

And whereas under the provisions of the said Act the Government of Trinidad and Tobago has agreed to borrow from Shell (Trinidad) Ltd., the sum of Two Million dollars in the currency of Trinidad and Tobago on the security of Bonds:

And whereas under the provisions of section 4 of the said Act the Minister of Finance may, for the purpose of securing the repayment of loans made under section 3 of the said Act, issue Bonds for terms of twenty years payable semi-annually and bearing interest at the rate of three per cent. per annum in such denominations as may be specified by resolution passed by the House of Representatives:

*Be it resolved:*

That Bonds in the sum of Two million dollars be issued to Shell (Trinidad) Ltd. in the denomination of \$100,000.00 in the currency of Trinidad and Tobago.
