AN ORDINANCE to amend the Indictable Offences
(Preliminary Enquiry) Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 1

[3rd February, 1955.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Indictable Offences
(Preliminary Enquiry) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and
shall be read as one with the Indictable Offences (Preliminary
Enquiry) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal
Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of section 27 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words and commas “, or who has been twice previously convicted of felony, whether summarily or on indictment” which appear in paragraph (c) thereof.
