Act No. 22 of 1973

AN ACT to amend the Gambling and Betting Act, 1963.

[Assented to 30th July, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Gambling and Betting Short title
(Amendment) Act, 1973.

Section 28
of the Act
amended

2. Section 28 of the Gambling and Betting Act, 1963, (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act") is amended by adding the following new subsection thereto—

"(6) Nothing in this Act shall be construed so as to permit the authority (within the meaning of paragraph 2 of the First Schedule) to grant any applicant a certificate or certificates authorising the issue of more than one betting office licence or pin ball machine licence, for each such licence, respectively, of which the applicant was the holder."

First Schedule
to the Act
amended

3. (1) Paragraph 14(e) of the First Schedule to the said Act is amended by substituting for all the words occurring therein after the words "1st day of January, 1967" the words "the holder, respectively, of such a valid and subsisting permit".

(2) Paragraph 16(1) of the First Schedule to the said Act is amended by inserting immediately after the words "in respect of any premises," occurring in lines two and three thereof the words "the authority may, in its discretion, grant a certificate authorising the issue of such licence, but so however that".

Application
of Act

4. This Act shall have effect in relation to all applications for betting office licences and permits to carry on such business as is mentioned in paragraph (a) or (b) of subsection (1) of section 27 of the said Act or for licences or permits to operate a pin ball machine under section 13 of the said Act, whether now pending or not.
