REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 45 OF THE
GAMBLING AND BETTING ACT

THE GAMBLING AND BETTING (TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS)
REGULATIONS, 1963

WHEREAS the Governor-General is empowered by section 45 of the Gambling and Betting Act, 1963, to make such regulations for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of that Act and of the Schedules thereto as may be necessary or expedient:

And whereas it appears to the Governor-General that it is expedient for the purpose of giving expeditious effect to the provisions of the Gambling and Betting Act, 1963, to make regulations with respect to applications for the grant of permits and licences made with respect to the date first fixed by the authority after the commencement of the said Act:

Now, therefore, the Governor-General in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 45 of the Gambling and Betting Act, 1963, hereby makes the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gambling and Betting (Transitional Provisions) Regulations, 1963.

2. In these Regulations "Act" means the Gambling and Betting Act, 1963.

3. For the purpose of an application for the grant of a permit to carry on such business as is mentioned in paragraph (a) or (b) of subsection (1) of section 27 of the Act or a permit to operate a pin ball machine under section 13 of the Act or a pin ball machine licence or a betting office licence, the provisions of these Regulations shall have effect as if they form part of the First Schedule to the Act.

4. Notwithstanding paragraph 3 of the First Schedule to the Act the authority may fix a day other than a day in the month of July, 1963, as the day on which he will hear and consider any application for the grant of a permit or licence.

5. The notice, required by paragraph 6 of the said First Schedule to the Act to be published in a newspaper circulating in Trinidad and Tobago not later than twenty-eight days before the hearing of any application, may be published not later than seven days before such hearing and shall state that any person who desires to object to the grant of a permit or licence shall send to the authority before such date not later than five days after the publication

of the advertisement as may be specified in the notice, two copies of a brief statement in writing of the grounds of his objection and the applicant shall cause the notice that is required by the said paragraph 6 to be posted up outside the entrance or on the site of the proposed entrance to the premises to be so posted up not later than four days before the date specified as aforesaid instead of not later than fourteen days as is required by the said paragraph 6.

6. The copy of the newspaper required by paragraph 7 of the said First Schedule to the Act to be sent to the authority not later than seven days after the publication thereof in such newspaper may be so sent to the authority not later than three days after its publication and the authority may consider such application at any time after the date specified in the advertisement instead of not earlier than fourteen days after that day as is required in the said paragraph 7 and the authority may dispense with the sending of the notice in writing of the date, time and place at which the application will be considered as is required by the said paragraph 7.

7. These Regulations shall have effect only in relation to applications for the grant of permits and licences made with respect to the date first fixed by the authority under regulation 4 after the commencement of the Act and are without prejudice to the application of any provision of the First Schedule to the Act is not inconsistent herewith.
