AN ORDINANCE to vest in the Board of Industrial Training the property of the Royal Victoria Institute and to amend the Industrial Training Ordinance.

[21st March, 1931.]

WHEREAS the Royal Victoria Institute of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporated) a company incorporated not for profit (hereinafter called "the Institute") was incorporated by, and carried on its objects in the Colony for a number of years under the provisions of, the Companies Ordinance;

And whereas by its memorandum of association it is provided that if upon the winding up or dissolution of the Institute there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Institute but shall be given or transferred to some other institution or institutions having objects similar to

the objects of the Institute to be determined by the members of the Institute at or before the time of dissolution ;

And whereas all debts and liabilities of the Institute have been satisfied and the members thereof have wound up the Institute and have determined to transfer its property to the Board of Industrial Training of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter called the Board) a Board incorporated by the Industrial Training Ordinance with similar objects ;

Now therefore be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Training (vesting and amendment) Ordinance, 1931.

2. All real and personal property in the Colony now held by or vested in the Institute shall be held by and vested in the Board its successors and assigns for the same estates and interests and to the extent which the same were respectively at the commencement of this Ordinance held or vested as aforesaid subject to the rights reservations and charges (if any) now affecting the same.

Amendment
of Cap. 150.

3. The Industrial Training Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) Section 6 :

- (i) paragraph (k) is hereby repealed ;
- (ii) at the end of the section the following paragraphs shall be added :
 - (k) to maintain and carry on the objects for which the Royal Victoria Institute was incorporated ;
 - (l) to let any part of the property derived from the Royal Victoria Institute for such purposes and at such rates as the Board may from time to time determine ;

(m) to do all such acts matters and things as may be necessary and proper to carry out the duties and functions of the Board.

(2) Section 7: After the word "regulations" and before the word "The" in the seventh line of the section the following shall be inserted:—

The Board may demand and receive fees for classes held or instruction given in connection with the objects for which the Royal Victoria Institute was incorporated.

(3) Section 11(1): In lieu of the word "seventeen" in the second line there shall be substituted the words "twenty-one."
