AN ORDINANCE to amend the Industrial Training  
Ordinance, Ch. 22. No. 1.

[By Notice]

Commencement.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Training  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with  
the Industrial Training Ordinance and shall come into force  
on a date to be fixed by the Governor by notice in the *Royal  
Gazette*.

Short title.

Partial repeal  
of Ch.22. No.1.

2. So much of the Industrial Training Ordinance as relates to the Royal Victoria Institute shall, on the coming into force both of this Ordinance and of the Royal Victoria Institute Ordinance, 1947, and subject to the provisions of the latter Ordinance, be deemed to be of no force or effect.

3. So much of the Industrial Training Ordinance as relates to the Institute for the Blind shall, on the coming into force both of this Ordinance and of the Trinidad and Tobago Blind Welfare Association Ordinance, 1947, and subject to the provisions of the latter Ordinance, be deemed to be of no force or effect.
