AN ORDINANCE to amend the Infants Ordinance, Ch. 5.No. 12.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Infants (Amendment) Short title.
Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Infants Ch. 5. No. 1.

2. Section 29 of the Infants Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section:—

“ Rules

29. Rules may be made in like manner as rules may be made under and for the purposes of the Judicature Ordinance for carrying the purposes of this Ordinance into effect, and for regulating the form and mode of procedure and, generally, the practice of the Court in respect of the matters to which this Ordinance relates, and for regulating the fees and allowances to all officers and solicitors of the Court in respect of such matters.”

Saving of
existing rules.

3. All rules of court made under the Infants Ordinance and in force at the commencement of this Ordinance shall remain in force as though this Ordinance had been in force when they were made and they had been made under the provisions of that Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
