A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 2 of the Forests Ordinance, Ch. 24. No. 1, that a "prohibited area" means a specified area, being part of a Forest Reserve or Crown Lands declared by the Governor in Council by proclamation to be a prohibited area :

And whereas it is expedient to declare the Crown Lands described in the Schedule hereto to be a prohibited area :

Now, therefore, after consultation with, and in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Acting Governor, do hereby declare and proclaim the Crown Lands referred to as North Sanctuary No. 3 and described in the Schedule hereto, to be a prohibited area.

SCHEDULE

NORTH SANCTUARY No. 3

All that area of Crown Land forming part of the Caroni Swamp, comprising approximately 72 acres and bounded as follows:—

- On the North—by the prohibited area described in Proclamation No. 28 of 1954 (Government Notice No. 156 of 1954) as the Northern Area and commonly known, and referred to in Proclamation No. 17 of 1958 (Government Notice No. 145 of 1958), as North Sanctuary No. 1;
- On the West—by a line demarcated by stakes running from the western end of the southern boundary of North Sanctuary No. 1 to the western end of the northern boundary of the prohibited area known, and described in Proclamation No. 17 of 1958, as North Sanctuary No. 2;
- On the South—by North Sanctuary No. 2; and
- On the East—by a line demarcated by stakes running due North from the eastern end of the northern boundary of North Sanctuary No. 2, to its junction with the southern boundary of North Sanctuary No. 1.
