### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 2 of the Forests Ordinance, Ch. 24. No. 1, that the Governor-General may by Proclamation declare that any specified area, being part of a Forest Reserve or Crown Lands, shall be a prohibited area.:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, do hereby declare Marble Island, London Bridge Rock and all the other adjacent islets and rocks belonging to the Crown and comprising St. Giles Islands to be a prohibited area.
