MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE
TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO CITIZENSHIP ACT, 1962

THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO CITIZENSHIP (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1970

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Citizenship (Amendment) Regulations, 1970.

2. The Eleventh Schedule to the Trinidad and Tobago Citizenship Regulations, 1962, is revoked and the following Schedule is substituted therefor:—

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF FINANCE UNDER SECTIONS 171(1) AND 143(7) OF
THE INSURANCE ACT, 1966

THE INSURANCE (PENSION FUND PLANS REGISTRATION FEES)
REGULATIONS, 1970

- Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Insurance (Pension Fund Plans Registration Fees) Regulations, 1970.
- Definitions. No. 24 of 1966. 2. In these Regulations—
“the Act” means the Insurance Act, 1966;
“Pension Fund Plan”, “Plan” and “Registered Plan” have the same meaning as in Part VI of the Act.
- Fee for registration of plan. 3. There shall be payable for the registration of any Plan a fee of fifty dollars.
- Fee for registration of amendments etc. 4. (1) Subject to regulation 2, there shall be payable for the registration of any amendment of the rules of a register plan or for any correction of the register occasioned by a change in the address of such plan or in the names or addresses of the trustees thereof, a fee of ten dollars.
(2) No fee shall be payable for the registration of any amendment or correction required, either expressly or by necessary implication, by any enactment.
- Fees payable to Comptroller of Accounts. 5. All fees prescribed by these Regulations shall be paid to the Comptroller of Accounts for account of the Supervisor of Insurance.
