**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Hindu Marriage (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Hindu Marriage Ordinance, 1945. Short title

2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Hindu Marriage Ordinance, 1945 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following subsection:—

“(1) It shall be lawful for the Governor, or any person duly authorised by him, to grant licences to such persons, being priests of the Hindu religion, as the Governor or such authorised person may, in his discretion, think fit, to be Marriage Officers, and, without assigning any reason for so doing, to cancel any such licence.”
