AN ACT to amend the Interpretation Act, 1962.

[Assented to 5th July, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Interpretation (Amend- Short title
ment) Act, 1974.

2. Section 35 of the Interpretation Act, 1962 is amended by repealing and replacing subsections (4) and (5) thereof as follows:—

“(4) Where the time limited by an enactment for the doing of anything expires or falls upon a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday, the time extends to and the things may be done on the first following day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday.

(5) Where by an enactment a period of time prescribed for the doing of anything does not exceed six days Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays shall not be included in the computation of the time.”.
