THE UNION PARK RACES (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)

ORDER, 1975

1. This Order may be cited as the Union Park Races (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1975. Citation

2. This Order shall come into operation at 10.00 a.m. on the 27th September, 1975 and shall cease at 7.30 p.m. on 11th October, 1975. Commence-  
ment and  
cessation

3. This Order shall have effect only during the periods commencing at 10.00 a.m. and ending at 7.30 p.m. on each of the undermentioned dates:— Application

27th September, 1975

4th October, 1975

11th October, 1975.

4. No person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain at any of the roads mentioned below:— Parking  
prohibited  
on certain  
roads

(a) Southern Main Road between the Guaracara Bridge and the Marabella Roundabout;

(b) Union Park;

(c) the roads of Gopaul Lands.

5. Parking on Union Park shall be as set out below:—

(a) Committee and Stewards of Union Park Race Club Special  
Parking—  
Union Park  
On spaces immediately North and South of the main entrance to the Stand;

(b) Member of Union Park Race Club  
West of the Stand;

(c) General Public  
West of the Paddock and on the northern side of Guaracara-Tabaquite Roads between Harmony Hall Road.

6. On the dates specified in paragraph 3 and between 5.00 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. vehicles travelling along the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road between the Southern Main Road and Union Road shall proceed in an easterly direction only. One-way  
traffic

7. (1) Vehicles approaching Union Park from a northerly direction shall proceed along the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road. Approach to  
Union Park

(2) On the days specified in paragraph 3 and during the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. vehicles approaching Union Park from a southerly direction shall proceed along Gopaul Road.

Exit from  
Union Park

8. On the dates specified in paragraph 3 between 5.00 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. vehicles leaving Union Park shall proceed along Gopaul Road.

Removal and  
impounding  
of vehicles  
unlawfully  
parked.

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78C of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance.

THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE, CH. 25. No. 9

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE

THE PROTECTION OF TURTLE AND TURTLE EGGS REGULATIONS,  
1975

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Protection of Turtle and Turtle Eggs Regulations, 1975.

Prohibition  
against  
taking  
possession of  
female turtle  
or taking,  
removing or  
selling  
turtle eggs

2. No person shall—

- (a) kill, harpoon, catch or otherwise take possession of any female turtle which is in the sea within any reef or within one thousand yards from the highwater mark of the foreshore where there is no reef;
- (b) take or remove or cause to be taken or removed any turtle eggs after they have been laid and buried by a female turtle or after they have been buried by any person;
- (c) purchase, sell, offer, or expose for sale or cause to be sold or offered or exposed for sale or be in possession of any turtle eggs.

3. No person shall, between the first day of March and the thirtieth day of September, kill, harpoon, catch or otherwise take possession of or purchase, sell, offer or expose for sale or cause to be sold or offered or exposed for sale any turtle or turtle meat.
