THE FISHERIES ACT, CHAP. 67:51

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE FISHERIES ACT

THE FISHERIES [CONTROL OF DEMERSAL (BOTTOM)
TRAWLING ACTIVITIES] (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,
1998

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries [Control of Demersal (Bottom) Trawling Activities] (Amendment) Regulations, 1998.

2. The Fisheries [Control of Demersal (Bottom) Trawling Activities] Regulations, 1996 are amended as follows:

Regulations 3
and 6 of Legal
Notice No. 196
of 1996
amended

(a) in regulation 3—

- (i) by renumbering subregulations (2) and (3) as subregulations (3) and (4) respectively; and
- (ii) by deleting subregulation (1) and substituting the following new subregulations:

“(1) Subject to this regulation, demersal (bottom) trawling for fish or shrimp is permitted in the territorial waters of the north coast at a distance outside of two nautical miles from that coast and west of Saut D’eau from the 15th of November to the 15th of January in each year.

(2) No person may carry out trawling of the kind referred to in subregulation (1) between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m.”;

(b) in regulation 6, by—

- (i) deleting the words “between the one fathom isobath and the coast line of the Gulf of Paria” occurring in subregulation (2) and substituting the words “at a distance inside of one nautical mile from the coast line of the Gulf of Paria”;

- (ii) deleting the word "four" occurring in subregulation (3) and substituting the word "six"; and
- (iii) deleting the word "eight" occurring in subregulation (4) and substituting the word "ten".
