AN ORDINANCE to amend the Harbours Ordinance.

[1st March, 1926.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbours Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1926, and shall be read as one Construction.
with the Harbours Ordinance, hereinafter called the Cap. 118.

2. The words " Offences for which the fine or penalty Amendment
does not " shall be substituted for the words " All such of s. 53 of
causes may be heard and determined in " in the first line of Cap. 118.
sub-section (2) of section 53 of the Principal Ordinance.
