AN ORDINANCE to amend the Harbours Ordinance,
Cap. 118.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbours Short title
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1938, and shall be read as one
with the Harbours Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as Cap. 118.
the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 34 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Sec. 34 of the
repealed and replaced by the following :— Principal
Ordinance
replaced.

34.—(1) The fees set out in the Schedule hereto shall
be payable in respect of boatmen and boats
licensed under the provisions of this Ordinance.
Such fees shall be paid to the Harbour Master
issuing the licence. The fees paid to the Harbour
Master of San Fernando shall, subject to the
provisions of Section 66 hereof, be for the use of
the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of San
Fernando; the fees payable in all other cases
shall be deposited to the general revenue of
the Colony.

(2) The Legislative Council may from time to time by resolution increase, reduce, or abolish, the fees set out in the Schedule hereto.

3. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Schedule :—
