AN ORDINANCE to amend the Harbours Ordinance,
Ch. 18. No. 1.

E NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbours (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949 and shall be read as one with the Harbours Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Repeal of
Section 18 (x)

2. Subsection (1) of Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following subsection:—

“18 (1) No launch, flat, lighter, drogher, boat or other craft shall be stationed or remain in such a position as to impede any ship in its approach to or departure from any pier, landing place or wharf. In case of contravention of the provisions of this subsection the person in charge of such offending craft or vessel shall be liable to a fine of Forty-eight Dollars.”

Passed in Council this twenty-seventh day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.
