A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 3(2) of the Harbours Ordinance, Ch. 18. No. 1 that the President may, by Proclamation, establish any harbour and define the limits thereof:

And whereas by Proclamation dated 6th August, 1965 the harbour of Point Lisas was established and its limits defined:

And whereas it is now necessary to alter the limits of that harbour as defined:

Now, therefore, I, ELLIS EMMANUEL INNOCENT CLARKE, redefine the limits of that harbour as set out in the Schedule hereunder:

SCHEDULE

All that portion of the Gulf of Paria bounded as follows:

- (i) to the North—by the line of latitude $10^{\circ} 25.1'$ North;
- (ii) to the West—by the line of longitude $61^{\circ} 32.1'$ West extending southwards to the point of intersection with the line of latitude $10^{\circ} 21.9'$ North;
- (iii) to the South—by the line of latitude $10^{\circ} 19.8'$ North extending westwards to the intersection of longitude $61^{\circ} 28.53'$ West—the line produced to join the southernmost point of the western boundary and the westernmost point of the southern boundary;
- (iv) to the East—by the high water mark of the shoreline between the northern and southern boundary lines.
