ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 52(1) OF  
THE INTERPRETATION ACT

THE DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS (SALOMON BROTHERS  
INTERNATIONAL LIMITED) (JAPANESE YEN 11,000,000,000  
BOND ISSUE) ORDER, 2000

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Functions (Salomon <sup>Citation</sup>  
Brothers International Limited) (Japanese Yen 11,000,000,000 Bond  
Issue) Order, 2000.

2. In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 52(1) of <sup>Delegation of</sup>  
the Interpretation Act, the Minister of Finance, Planning and <sup>Functions</sup>  
Development hereby delegates the functions he is empowered to <sup>Chap. 3:01</sup>  
perform under section 3(1) of the External Loans Act, in respect of the <sup>Chap. 71:05</sup>  
execution on June 27, 2000, of the documents described hereunder, to  
Ms. Shelagh de Osuna, Trinidad and Tobago High Commissioner to  
London, England (hereafter called “the High Commissioner”).

3. The High Commissioner is hereby empowered to execute the <sup>Documents to</sup>  
following documents in respect of the 3.75% Japanese Yen <sup>be executed</sup>  
11,000,000,000 Bond Issue to be arranged, managed and fully  
underwritten by Salomon Brothers International Limited:

- (a) the Purchase Agreement;
- (b) the Fiscal Agency Agreement;
- (c) the Deed of Covenant;
- (d) the Permanent Global Note evidencing the Bond Issue (and  
any Definitive Notes);
- (e) the Private Placement Memorandum; and
- (f) all other documents, certificates and instruments to be  
executed under or in connection with the Purchase  
Agreement and the Fiscal Agency Agreement.
