Act No. 12 of 1969

AN ACT to amend the Housing Act, 1962.

[Assented to 11th April, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Housing (Amendment) Short Title
Act, 1969.

2. The Housing Act, 1962 is hereby amended—

- (a) in section 11, by substituting the words “twenty-five” for the word “twenty” respectively occurring immediately before the word “thousand” in paragraphs (a) and (b) thereof;
- (b) in section 14—
- (i) by substituting the words “not exceeding such sum” for the words beginning with the words “not exceeding” occurring in line four of subsection (1) thereof to the word “mortgage” occurring in line six thereof;
- (ii) by substituting for subsection (2) thereof, the following—
- “(2) The insurance fee may be included in the loan secured by the mortgage referred to in subsection (1) and is payable at such time or times as may be specified in the guarantee.”;
- (c) in section 19, by adding the words “except for the purposes specified in paragraph (d) of section 18” immediately after the word “house” occurring in paragraph (b) thereof;
- (d) by substituting the words “Trinidad and Tobago” for the word “Territory” wherever that word occurs therein.
