AN ACT to amend the Housing Act, 1962.

[Assented to 4th June, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Housing (Amendment) ^{Short title}
Act, 1976.

2. The Housing Act is amended—

(a) by repealing and replacing section 11 as follows—

“Applica-
tion of
Part

11. (1) This Part applies to—

(a) a newly constructed dwelling-house, the cost of construction of which, in the opinion of the Authority, having regard to normal building costs prevailing at the time of its construction, would not exceed sixty thousand dollars, inclusive of the cost and value of the land, and

(b) any other house the purchase price of which is not more than sixty thousand dollars, inclusive of the cost and value of the land.

(2) The Minister of Finance may by Order publish in the *Gazette* vary the amounts specified in paragraphs (a) and (b).”

Commencement

3. This Act is deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1976.
