NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the eight parcels of land described in the Schedule together comprising 16,458m² more or less situate between the 2.5 kilometre mark and the 3.7 kilometre mark along Ganteaume Trace, Nestor Village, Sangre Grande, in the Ward of Turure, in the County of St. Andrew are lands likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Road Improvement.

SCHEDULE

Eight parcels of land containing together 16,458m² more or less situate between the 2.5 kilometre mark and the 3.7 kilometre mark along Ganteaume Trace, Nestor Village, Sangre Grande, in the Ward of Turure, in the County of St. Andrew and comprised as follows:

- (a) a parcel of land comprising approximately 6990.0m² belonging now or formerly to Gordon Grant Investment Limited;
- (b) a parcel of land comprising approximately 198m² belonging now or formerly to Pascal Libert;
- (c) a parcel of land comprising approximately 1122m² belonging now or formerly to Basdeo Baran;
- (d) a parcel of land comprising approximately 1002m² belonging now or formerly to Louisa Thomas;
- (e) a parcel of land comprising approximately 3304m² belonging now or formerly to John La Fon;
- (f) a parcel of land comprising approximately 1700m² belonging now or formerly to Philomina Edwards;
- (g) a parcel of land comprising approximately 921m² belonging now or formerly to Jagdeo Dhanbir;
- (h) a parcel of land comprising approximately 1221m² belonging now or formerly to Mary E. Monceaux;
