NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC  
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land together comprising 2030 m<sup>2</sup> more or less, described in the Schedule and situate at Mendez Drive, Diego Martin in the Ward of Diego Martin in the County of St. George are lands likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Extension of the Diego Martin Highway.

SCHEDULE

Four parcels of land containing together 2030 m<sup>2</sup> more or less, situate at Mendez Drive, Diego Martin in the Ward of Diego Martin in the County of St. George and comprised as follows:

- (a) a parcel of land comprising approximately 460 m<sup>2</sup> belonging now or formerly to Navarro;
- (b) a parcel of land comprising approximately 520 m<sup>2</sup> belonging now or formerly to Olga Thomas;
- (c) a parcel of land comprising approximately 570 m<sup>2</sup> belonging now or formerly to Ursa Chowquan;
- (d) a parcel of land comprising approximately 480 m<sup>2</sup> belonging now or formerly to F. Mendez.
