MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 4(1) OF
THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT

THE LAND ACQUISITION (POSSESSION OF LAND PRIOR TO
FORMAL VESTING IN THE STATE) (NO. 63) ORDER, 1998

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Possession of
Land Prior to Formal Vesting in the State) (No. 63) Order, 1998.

Possession of 2. The Commissioner of State Lands is authorised to take
land possession of land comprising a strip approximately 50 metres wide
more or less, configured with 25 metres on either side of the centerline
of the re-aligned Caparo River, transversing several parcels, situated
between the Caparo Valley Road in the east and Perseverance Road to
the west in the Borough of Chaguanas, in the County of Caroni and
described in the Notification in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*,
Volume 35, No. 132, dated 3rd July, 1996 at Item No. 1445, before the
formal vesting of the land in the State, and to apply it to the purpose for
which it is intended to be put on acquisition.
