NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC  
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land described in the Schedule and situate on both sides of the Cascade River between Strathclyde Avenue on the east and a private road bounding the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T.&T.E.C.) compound on the west in the Ward of St. Ann's in the County of St. George are lands, likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: To facilitate drainage improvement to the Cascade River.

## SCHEDULE

Several parcels of land comprising 1450 square metres, situate on both sides of the Cascade River between Strathclyde Avenue on the east and a private road bounding the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T.&T.E.C.) compound on the west in the Ward of St. Ann's in the County of St. George and said to belong now or formerly to Sosa, Morales, Ghany and Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T.&T.E.C.).
