NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land described in the Schedule and situate at Toco in the Ward of Toco in the County of St. David are lands likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: The Development of and accessibility to the site for the Port at Toco.

SCHEDULE

Several parcels of land identified on Cadastral Sheet 6c, filed in the Vault of the Lands and Surveys Division together comprising approximately 17 hectares situate in the Ward of Toco in the County of St. David which are bounded on the north by Toco Bay, on the south by several parcels of land along the northern side of the Paria Main Road and including the northern portion of the parcel of land belonging now or formerly to the heirs of Charles Fabien, on the east by State lands, lands of Kim Warner and others and lots along the Paria Main Road, and on the west by Toco Bay and lands belonging now or formerly to the heirs of Antoinette Garcia.
