NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC  
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcel of land known as Indian Walk Estate described in the Schedule and situate at Moriah, Tobago, in the Ward of Tobago is land likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Management and protection of the Courland Watershed.
