NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC  
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land described in the Schedule and situate in the vicinity of the junction of Carat Hill Trace and New Colonial Road, Barrackpore, in the Ward of Naparima, in the County of Victoria are lands likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Diversion of a section of the Oropouche River.

SCHEDULE

Two parcels of land together comprising 4,500 square metres more or less, situate in the vicinity of the junction of Carat Hill Trace and New Colonial Road, Barrackpore, in the Ward of Naparima, in the County of Victoria and said to belong now or formerly to Celina Adharsingh and Moonilal P. Mitchell and Robert Mitchell, respectively.
